ROSEMARY RUTLEY is a well-known local author who has written several books steeped in the history of the area. *Voices from the Lost Villages*, published in 1995, is one of her best-known works. She has also written about the histories of her church, St. Matthew's Presbyterian Church in Ingleside (2002), and of the cheese factories in Stormont, Dundas and Glengarry (2005). For this reading she will draw from her latest work, *A Place by the River* (2021), a collection of historical fiction stories inspired by those who lived in and around the lost riverside villages of the St. Lawrence River before and after the St. Lawrence Seaway and Power Development Project of the 1950s.

A regular on the TSCH stage, Montreal-based **JIM ROBINSON** is a prolific singer-songwriter with a distinctive voice. Originally from Quebec's Eastern Townships, Jim draws on the oral tradition of his rural roots and a broad range of musical influences. Jim has just released his 11th album titled *all alone – The Apartment Songs*, which he recorded on his own with one mic, one voice, one guitar, one take, a radical change from his previous collaborations with producer Jason Lang. With his partner **SUSAN FOWLER** on backup vocals, Jim continues to engage his audiences with singable choruses, foot-tapping rhythms and stories about memorable people, tinged with his whimsical response to life's ironies.
